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Agricultural Business Management Program to Help Families Thrive

ENID, OKLA. — Autry Technology Center is now accepting enrollment for the Agricultural Business Management Program. This program will begin Tuesday, November 6, 2018, and will meet monthly on Tuesday evenings from 6:30 to 9 p.m. at Autry Technology Center.

“This program is designed to bring the benefits of instruction in Agricultural Business Management to farm families,” said Don Roberts, ABM coordinator. “The main focus of the program will be helping farm families and farm operators to establish and achieve farm business and family goals.”

Those attending will learn about financial management and analysis, record keeping and marketing. They will also receive information on risk management, understanding financial statements and more. Participants can also schedule individual farm visits with the instructor to discuss specific goals and financial decisions confidentially. The ABM course satisfies Farm Service Agency’s borrower training requirements as well.

Class size will be limited and enrollments will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis. In-district cost for books and tuition are \$100.00 per farm couple.
