Autry Partners with Aircraft Structures International Corporation to Provide Paid Training Program

ENID, Okla. – Aircraft Structures International Corporation wants to hire you. With the Airframe Structures Technology Course, you can get paid to train for the “World Leader” in Cessna Caravan repairs.

ASIC, opened in 1978 in Pond Creek, Okla. and relocated to Enid in 1992, where they remain today. They have the tools and ability to rebuild every Caravan structural component no matter how severe the damage. They employ more than 70 people and were awarded the Lt. Governor’s Small Business Award of Excellence in 2016.

This course was developed for entry-level sheet metal workers. It was created to familiarize the mechanic with basic structural repair fundamentals that are required to produce a finished repair that complies with the Cessna 208/208B Maintenance Manuals and applicable tech data.

During the training period, the students will become employees of ASIC and a wage of \$10 per hour will be earned during the four-week period. Upon satisfactory completion, each student will be offered a position as a sheet metal technician at a starting wage of \$13 per hour. Following the successful completion of a 90-day probationary period, a raise to \$14 per hour is possible.

The classes will match the four-day, 10-hour per day work week schedule that ASIC maintains during the four weeks of training. All tools will be provided during training. Once training is complete, each technician will supply their own hand tools. Students will need to provide their own lockable tool chest.
