### **Autry Technology Center Accepting Applications for Full-time Programs**

ENID, Okla. – Full-time programs are set to begin on Aug. 14, 2019, at Autry Technology Center. Autry offers several full-time programs, enrolling more than 700 high school and adult students each year.

Limited spots remain in the following full-time programs: Air Conditioning & Refrigeration Technology (PM and Evening), Automotive Technology (PM only), Business Management & Entrepreneurship (PM only), Clinical Medical Assisting (AM & PM), Collision Repair Technology (PM only), Computer-Aided Drafting & Design (PM only), Dental Assisting (AM & PM), Health Careers (PM only), Information Technology (PM only), Power Products Technology (PM only) and Robotics & Electronic Automation (PM only).

Full-time programs are available for both adults and high school juniors and seniors and run August through May, much like a traditional school year. Enrollment for full-time programs begins in January and continues through August. In-district high school juniors and seniors can attend a full-time program tuition free. The Autry Scholarship is available to recent high school graduates who (1) live in the Autry district, (2) lived in the Autry district during their senior year in high school, and (3) meet enrollment guidelines. Students may attend during any or all of the three years immediately following high school graduation.
