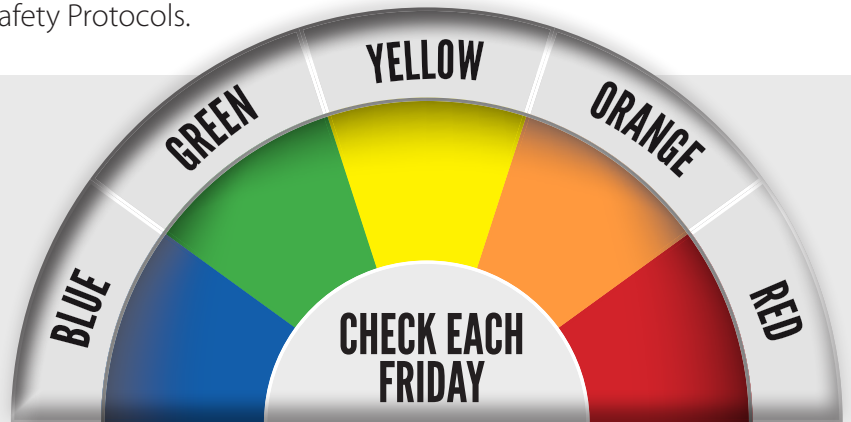

Autry Tech's Status Guidelines including instructional modes, learning environments, and prevention measures incorporate recommendations from the Oklahoma State Department Education's School Safety Protocols.



**Each Friday**, Autry Tech will align our Adaptable Health Pandemic Response Plan with the **Oklahoma State Department of Health's COVID-19 Alert System**, designed to assess risk for exposure in counties across the state utilizing a four-tiered risk measurement tool with corresponding color categories.

**GREEN** - less than 1.43 daily new cases per 100,000 population

**YELLOW** - between 1.43 and 14.29 daily new cases per 100,000 population

**ORANGE** - more than 14.29 daily new cases per 100,000 population

**RED** - more than 14.29 daily new cases per 100,000 population & Region 1 COVID-19 patients represent 40% or more of staffed beds (Acute Care OSDH licensed facilities)

## PLEASE REVIEW THE STATUS GUIDELINES INCLUDING IMPORTANT CRITERIA FOR EACH PLAN.

As the Workforce Capital, Autry Tech's most valuable asset is hands-on training, and although this delivery method may become unavailable, our goal is to provide learning environments in such a manner that will continue to provide a productive and prepared workforce for employers. As the situation continues to evolve, students and parents/guardians will be notified as our status changes.

Students are expected to attend class in scheduled a.m. and p.m. times utilizing designated instructional modes including full-time program areas, mathematics coursework and Oklahoma School of Science and Mathematics (OSSM). Teachers will also be available during normal classroom hours M-F to assist students with issues or concerns. Student/teacher communication may consist of Open LMS, email, Google Classroom, Google Meet, Zoom, text message or phone calls. Academic expectations and integrity remain enforced. Instructors will communicate with students and will share coursework details.

If Autry Tech is operating in a status that includes an in-person instructional mode (blue, green, yellow and orange), all full-time high school students are expected to attend programs at Autry Tech regardless of the status of their respective partner school. Partner schools will provide transportation if needed. Should you receive quarantine instructions from your partner school, please communicate with Janet Strate or Jeff Huffman, Directors of Full-Time Programs, in order to receive further instruction and discuss attendance exceptions.

Students in our full-time programs that do not operate on the traditional schedule (Evening HVAC, Industrial & Mechanical Technology and Advanced Medical programs) will be contacted individually about an alternative plan.
