INSTRUCTIONAL MODES & LEARNING ENVIRONMENTS

As the Workforce Capital, Autry Tech's most valuable asset is our credible hands-on training, and our mission is to deliver instructional modes that will provide a productive and prepared workforce for employers in Oklahoma.

- In-Person (IP)- On campus, hands-on training with in-person instruction
- Off-Campus (OC)- Off campus, hands-on training with in-person instruction
- 24/7 Online Access- curriculum and OpenLMS connecting instructors, students and guardians (available in designated full-time programs and training courses)

FULL-TIME PROGRAMS

- Full-Time students will be on campus with hands-on training and in-person instruction starting Wednesday, August 11, 2021.
- NO Virtual Content (VC) or Online Instruction (OI). Instructors should be contacted if curriculum assistance is needed.

SHORT-TERM COURSES & CORPORATE TRAINING

- Short-Term students are on campus with hands-on training and in-person instruction.
- Corporate training and client visits are provided at outside facilities.

ON CAMPUS EVENTS & VISITORS

- Outside events and room reservations are available.
- Common areas, break rooms, food and drinks are permitted at all Autry Tech locations.

FULL-TIME STUDENT ACTIVITIES AND ORGANIZATIONS

- Student activities and organization meetings will be permitted with the guidelines, if necessary, provided by Full-time Program Directors and Student Services Director.

At Autry Technology Center, the health, safety and well-being of our students and staff are our top priorities. We have taken extraordinary steps since reopening our campus to protect our tech center community. We will continue to rigorously adhere to local, state and CDC mandates. The Autry Tech Leadership Team will continue to monitor case counts in our community and will modify on campus procedures, if necessary. REDUCE RISK OF EXPOSURE

- Students, visitors and employees should wash hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds prior to eating, and especially after sneezing, coughing, and blowing their nose.
- Additional deep cleaning and disinfecting measures will continue for sanitation efforts at all Autry Tech locations.



PROTECTION

- Oklahoma Senate Bill 658, effective July 1st, 2021, restricts the mandatory enforcement of masks in schools unless a state of emergency is declared by the Governor, consultation with the health department, and school board consideration.
- Masks will be optional for students, employees and visitors at all Autry Tech locations.
- State and local health departments and the CDC recommend vaccinated and unvaccinated people wear masks indoors.
- Masks will be available for individuals who wish to wear one.



VACCINATIONS

- Oklahoma Senate Bill 658, effective July 1st, 2021, restricts school districts from requiring a COVID-19 vaccine for students.
- State and local health departments and the CDC recommend COVID-19 vaccines for those eligible.



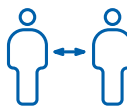
MONITORING FOR SYMPTOMS

- Parents/guardians, students, visitors and employees are expected to screen themselves for COVID-19 symptoms and other illness symptoms each day prior to accessing any Autry Tech location.
- Per CDC recommendations, students, visitors and employees are advised to stay home if experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 or any other illness.
- Any student or employee who is determined to be affected with a contagious health condition such as head lice, bed bugs, strep throat, the flu, pink eye, or COVID-19 shall be prohibited from attending school until a health care professional (licensed physician, licensed physician's assistant, health department official, school nurse, etc.) has determined that the individual is free of the condition or that there is no danger of the condition spreading to others in the school environment.



POSITIVE CASES

- Students, visitors and employees who test positive for COVID-19 must follow recommendations by health care professionals and provide documentation.
 - **HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS** - students remaining home because of a documented positive COVID-19 test will not be penalized regarding absences. A parent/guardian must provide positive test results from a health care professional to rsnider@autrytech.edu AND notify the Student Services Office at Autry Tech (580)242.2750.
 - **ADULT STUDENTS** - students remaining home because of a documented positive COVID-19 test will not be penalized regarding absences. You must provide positive test results from a health care professional to rsnider@autrytech.edu AND notify the Student Services Office at Autry Tech at (580)242.2750.
 - **SHORT-TERM COURSE STUDENTS, CORPORATE TRAINING CLIENTS & CAMPUS VISITORS** - Please notify Autry Tech at (580)242.2750 of your time on campus at any Autry Tech location if within the past 72 hours.
 - **AUTRY TECH EMPLOYEES** - Please notify administration and provide positive test documentation from a health care professional.
- As Autry Tech receives confirmation of individuals who test positive for COVID-19 at any location, reported cases will be documented at https://autrytech.edu/coronavirus/#reported_cases. While we must protect the privacy of our students, visitors and employees, we believe it is best to communicate transparently with individuals to make well-informed decisions regarding their health.



QUARANTINE

- **HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS** - Autry Tech will follow partner school guidelines, if a student is required to quarantine.
 - Partner school quarantine documents are required to not be penalized regarding absences. **OR**
 - If quarantine is required by a healthcare professional, a parent/guardian must provide documentation from the health care professional to rsnider@autrytech.edu.
- **ADULT STUDENTS** - No quarantine option unless you have documentation requiring quarantine from a health care professional due to exposure or positive test.
 - If an employer issues a quarantine, students will still be required to attend class unless there is documentation from a health professional or a positive test result.
 - If quarantine is required by a healthcare professional, you must provide documentation from the health care professional to rsnider@autrytech.edu.
