### **Autry Technology Center Board of Education Approves Local Agreements at November Board Meeting**

ENID, Okla. – Autry Technology Center’s Board of Education approved two local agreements at their meeting on Nov. 1, 2021.

The board voted to approve the agreement for the transfer of a 1997 Pierce Sabre Fire Engine to Autry Technology Center from the City of Enid. The Enid Fire Department is taking the truck out of commission and donating it to Autry Technology for fire training. The donation will allow Autry Tech to have two pump trucks available for live burns and future training opportunities.

The board also voted to approve a license agreement between Autry Technology Center and Jumbo Food, LLC. Another meeting with the City of Enid, Jumbo Foods, LLC and Autry Technology Center will take place before 2022 to discuss further plans of property usage, street accessibility and additional partnerships for the future.

Autry Technology Center has been a part of the Enid community since 1967 and is one of 29 CareerTech schools across Oklahoma. The center has more than 25 career programs and offers a wide variety of evening and weekend short-term courses and certifications for many diverse career fields. Autry serves nearly 16,000 individuals each year, including many area employees who receive training through the Corporate Training Department that works with over 500 local businesses each year.
