ENID, Okla. – Full-time programs are set to begin on Aug. 10, 2022, at Autry Technology Center. Autry Tech offers several full-time programs, enrolling more than 700 high school and adult students each year.

Limited spots remain in the following full-time programs: Air Conditioning & Refrigeration Technology (PM), Automotive Technology (PM), Business & Office Services (AM & PM), Clinical Medical Assisting (AM & PM), Collision Repair Technology (AM & PM), Computer-Aided Drafting & Design (PM), Computerized Machining (CNC Machining) (AM & PM), Construction Technology (PM), Dental Assisting (AM & PM), Early Care & Hospitality (AM & PM), Graphic Arts (PM), Health Careers (AM & PM), Information Technology (PM), Medical Front Office (PM) and Robotics & Electronic Automation (PM).

Full-time programs are available for both adults and high school juniors and seniors and run August through May, much like a traditional school year. In-district high school juniors and seniors can attend a full-time program tuition free. The Autry Scholarship is available to recent high school graduates who (1) live in the Autry district, (2) lived in the Autry district during their senior year in high school, and (3) meet enrollment guidelines. Students may attend during any or all of the three years immediately following high school graduation.
