### **Autry Technology Center to Offer Civilian Response to Active Shooter Events Training**

ENID, Okla. – Autry Technology Center is set to offer CRASE Training – Civilian Response to Active Shooter Events – on Monday, Sept. 12 from 6 to 8 p.m., in partnership with OSBI and other Enid-area law enforcement agencies.

The Civilian Response to Active Shooter Events (CRASE) course provides strategies, guidance and a proven plan for surviving an active shooter event. This course is designed and built on the Avoid, Deny Defend (ADD) strategy developed by ALERRT in 2004.

Topics include:

- The history and prevalence of active shooter events
- Civilian response options
- Medical issues
- Considerations for conducting drills

Attendees will gain a better understanding of law enforcement and first responder response scenarios. They will also earn tools that can save their life and the lives of those around them during this free, two-hour training.
